**Hebrew: "helel," bright/shining one  
About 700 BC**

**Septuagint: "heosphoros," light/dawn bringer  
About 200 BC**

**Around 100 BC, non-biblical stories circulate,  
associating Satan with Heosphoros.**

**Vulgate: "lucifer," light bringer, or a name  
About 400 AD**

**KJV: "Lucifer," used as a name  
1611 AD**
