ACCORDING TO "LOST GOSPELS"

Jesus was fully human and fully divine

Jesus was a spirit who seemed human or a mere human uniquely inhabited by a divine spirit (Gnostic gospels)

Judas Iscariot willingly chose to betray Jesus

Jesus told Judas to betray him  
(*Gospel of Judas*)

The first miraculous sign that Jesus performed was turning water to wine at Cana

Jesus performed self-serving miracles throughout his childhood ("infancy Gospels")
